

Free Tours

Every Wednesday afternoon, from May through September, 't Gilde de Bevelanden offers free guided tours of Goes. Starting at 2.00 p.m., each tour lasts around an hour and a half. The guide can be found at the entrance to the Historic Museum / Tourist information office (VVV) on Singelstraat. No advance booking required.



About the municipality of Goes

The city of Goes and the surrounding villages of Kloetinge, 's-Heer Hendrikskinderen, 's-Heer Arendskerke, Wilhelminadorp, Kattendijke and Wolphaartsdijk together form the municipality of Goes. Goes (population 37,800) is located in the centre of Zeeland on the Eastern Scheldt and Lake Veere.

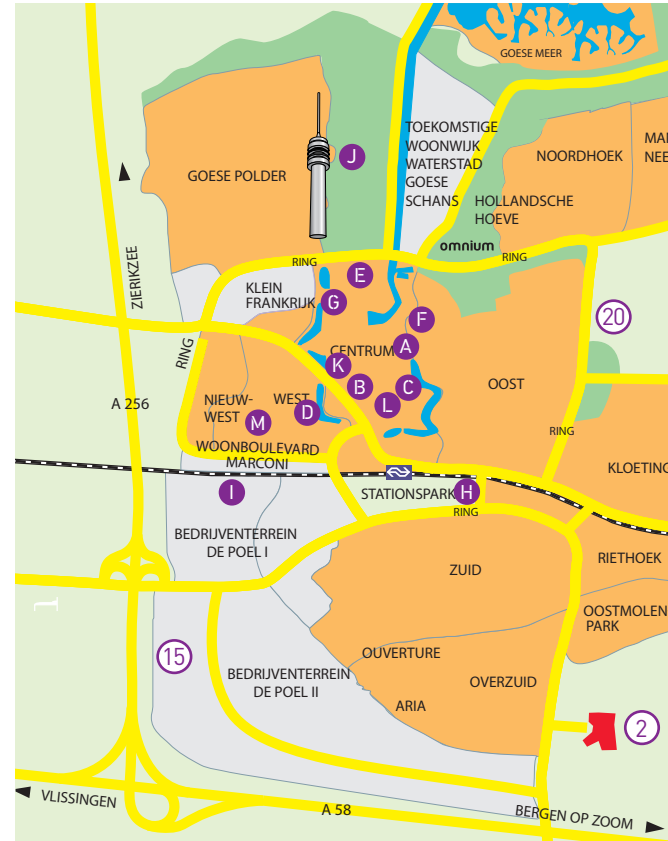

PAID PARKING

Paid parking in Goes applies at the following times:

- Mon, Tues, Wed, Fri: 9.00 a.m. - 6.00 p.m.
- Thurs: 9.00 a.m. - 9.00 p.m.
- Sat: 9.00 a.m. - 5.00 p.m.

Parking is free on Sundays and public holidays.

These parking times do not apply to the Centrum parking garage, Westwal 35, 4461 CM Goes.

FREE PARKING

Free parking is available on the Steam Railway grounds and at the Station Park on the southern

side of the station, accessible from the Fruitlaan, taking the 'Stationspark' exit (signposted). In addition, there is free parking in the car park at 't Schenge sports park, which can be accessed from the Westhavendijk. Buses may also park there.

CHARGING POINTS

Charging points operated by Allego are available at three city centre locations. These charging points are located on Molenplein, Hollandia plein and the Stationspark car park.

Six charging points operated by Ecotap are available on the third floor of Centrum parking garage. Rapid-charging points are located at the car park on Amundsenweg, opposite Sturm car dealership and on the A58 Middelburg - Roosendaal motorway, marker post ID 151.

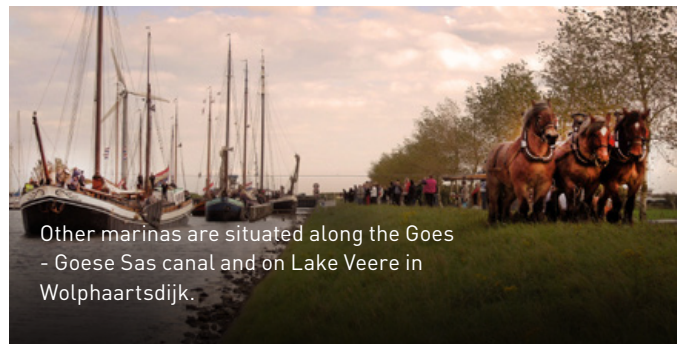

MANHUISTUIN CONCERTS

Starting in May, concerts are given in the magnificent Manhuistuin every Sunday from noon until 1.15 p.m., or if the weather is bad, in St Mary Magdalene Church (Grote Kerk). Summer break from 15 July to 19 August.

'De Hollandsche Hoeve' urban recreation park is located within walking distance of the centre of Goes. Don't miss the Omnium, a complex comprising a tropical plant kingdom, swimming pools, super water slides, steam rooms, squash courts and sports halls.

'De Hollandsche Hoeve' transforms a day out in Goes into a party. This free recreation park offers a wide range of attractions including a petting zoo, an eatery with indoor playground and miniature golf course, a Handicraft centre, an outdoor playground, an Environmental Education Centre, the largest leisure centre in Zeeland with the best swimming pool and a unique tropical garden. A striking feature of 'De Hollandsche Hoeve' are the twelve benches made by local artists.
